

DISASTER MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP

The NSS unit of Kalindi College organised a workshop on disaster management on 5th November, 2016. The workshop commenced at 10:00 AM in the Sangam Parisar which was hosted by Ipshita Mandal, a student from B.A. (H) Journalism. She welcomed the trainers: Mr.Rajan Arora, Mr.Naresh Kumar, Mr.Pawan Saini and Ms Neha. Mr.Rajan Arora addressed the audience first and briefly described about incidence, accident and disaster. The students were then addressed by Mr. Dinesh Kumar who further elaborated the meaning of disaster by giving examples of J&K and Uttrakhand. He talked about earthquake and pre measures which everyone can take. He explained some rescue techniques such as 3 hand seat, 4 hand seat and stretcher from bedsheet or any piece of cloth. This was followed by a talk from Mr. Pawan Saini who gave immense knowledge about first aid and techniques to rescue the casualties. He was helped by Ms Neha who demonstrated a lot of methods to stop blood flow and techniques to tie different knots. Further, the students were given a chance to have a hands-on experience of the training given during the session. The whole day winded up with the huge knowledge imparted by speakers and devotion displayed by students.
