

## Report on visit to FAMILY OF DISABLED



Family of Disabled (FOD) is a registered not-for-profit organisation serving persons with disabilities since 1992. It was founded by Rajinder Johar, himself a quadriplegic who has been bedridden for the last 22 years. The organization's vision is to see every person with disability leading a dignified, financially secure and productive life by enabling disabled people with low socio-economic status to earn their livelihood,

promoting quality education amongst children, encouraging artists and artisans with disabilities to showcase their talent and creating awareness on issues related to disability. Besides these, FoD takes other initiatives to mainstream persons with disabilities.

Four students of Kalindi College (Hema, Gurpreet, Guneet and Bhavya of B.A.(Prog.) Part I) along with their teacher Dr. Shalini Aggarwal visited the premises of the Family of Disabled located at Najafgarh on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2015 to understand the problems faced by disabled persons and functioning of the organization for the cause of the disabled. The coordinator of the organization showed a presentation about their organization and explained the programmes organized by them such as Apna Rozgar Scheme, Mobile Rehab Services, and Placement Cell etc. along with a visit to their latest constructed project, the UNNATI REHABILISATION CENTRE built BY FOD in Najafgarh.
