

## **NSS DAY REPORT**

On the occasion of NSS Day, 24th September, NSS Unit of Kalindi College organized a series of social events for the enthusiastic students to come forward and contribute for a well-being. There were three events including Cleanliness Drive, Dengue Awareness Rally and Street Play Competition on the theme cleanliness and dengue awareness.

The celebration began with a Cleanliness Drive at 9:30 am.
